- Lunch w Jack Harman -

I) Wt gain data reviewed w Jack G.

Jack was very impressed w assoc betw appetite and wt gain. [He commented that this would make a good contribution to Am J Psy].

II) DM data reviewed w Jack G

He was not impressed w OLR assoc of wt gain and increased blood glucose.

III) GSMIT hyperglycemia data reviewed w Jack G.

He sees DM/hypergly as common illness rather than an OLR effect.

He did not think that there was an OLR effect on Pancreas.

IV) Jack's 3 conclusions:

1. Wt. gain w OLR-R in ~ 10+ lbs / yr.

2. Wt. gain w OLR-R is a manageable problem:

i. assoc w ↑ appetite

ii. plateaus over 6-12 mos.

iii. can be managed through psychod Rx's.

3. P's (in general) who ≥ 10% baseline wt.

should have blood glucose checked.

V) Jack strongly feels that Lilly needs to get above msg. out.

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
